

Choir Performance and Extra Rehearsal Excusal Form

Choir is a performing arts class and one of our main goals is to perform. If you need to miss a performance, due to a vacation that was planned before the school year started, you will need to fill out this form completely and turn it in to Dr. Thorpe by **Aug. 23**. If you miss a performance due to an illness or an emergency, you are expected to turn in the form **within a week after the concert** to receive up to full credit.

Examples of Valid Excusals:

- A commitment that was planned BEFORE you found out about the concert dates for the school year. The concert dates are provided on the first day of class.
- Extreme illness (throwing up, hospitalization, etc.)
- Important family events (like funerals and weddings of close family members)

Examples of Unacceptable Excuses:

- Church activities
- Babysitting
- Recitals or concerts of any kind
- Non MMHS Sports practices/games
- **Family vacations that are planned AFTER you found out about the concert.**
- You just didn't feel good
- You forgot
- Etc.
